DURATION: 9.8 weeks

What is included:

- Each student will have use of a technology station for online learning, which includes monitor, laptop/computer, keyboard, mouse. We strive to make their learning environment effective and
- Weekly theme of STEAM projects, such as Stop Motion Animation, Robotics, Flight, Rocks and Minerals. We do try to align projects with outcomes students are doing in school.
- Daily Stations: With Weekly themes, each day has different challenges. This includes: Maker Space, Lego Lab, Discovery Stations (boardgames or coding), Movement Break, Reading Corner (Guided reading at least once a week), Typing. This gives kids fun and engaging breaks to create or get physical activities.
- Dojo Classroom: We document their projects or activities we are doing at DC Academy. Students can share what they have created. Parents and grandparents can see their child's activities.
- Use of common writing and crafting tools. I.e. pencils, pencil crayons, markers, glue, scissors, etc.

HEALTH AND SAFETY:
